Caden Lap Blanket



Skill Level: 

Size: Approximately 30" x 40"

Lap blanket in this photo is slightly different from actual pattern. Please create according to our pattern.

Materials: 1400 yards worsted weight yarn
or 700 yards chunky weight yarn

Needles: US #13-32" circular needle

Notions: Right side marker, tapestry needle

Gauge: 12 stitches = 4" in garter stitch (knit every row)
11 stitches = 4" in pattern stitch

Abbreviations:
k = knit
p = purl

Note:

If you are using worsted weight yarn you will be double stranding the yarn throughout the pattern. If using chunky yarn you will be using it single stranded throughout the pattern.

The Pattern:

Cast on 89 stitches

Starting Border: Knit 10 rows

Rows 1, 3 & 5: k5, *k7, p1; repeat from * until 12 stitches left, k12 (placing marker on first row to denote right side of lap blanket)

Rows 2, 4 & 6: k5, p79, k5

Rows 7 & 9: k5, p8, *k7, p9; repeat from * until 12 stitches left, k12

Rows 8 & 10: k5, p79, k5

Rows 11, 13 & 15: k5, *k7, p1; repeat from * until 12 stitches left, k12

Rows 12, 14 & 16: k5, p79, k5

Rows 17 & 19: k5, *k7, p9; repeat from * until 20 stitches left, k7, p8, k5

Rows 18 & 20: k5, p79, k5

Repeat Rows 1-20 until lap blanket measures 38 inches from the cast on edge, after having just finished Row 5.

Ending Border: Knit 10 rows

Finishing:

Bind off loosely.

Weave in all ends.
