

Harvest Leaves Garland  
Size 8 DP needles

k- knit

p- purl

m1r- make 1 right

m1l- make 1 left

ssk- slip, slip, knit

k2tog- knit 2 stitches together

k3tog- knit 3 stitches together

We are going to start with the stem of the leaf:

Using the long tail method, cast on 3 stitches.

Work 3 rows of icord.

M 1 L – Lift stitch from front to back. K in back loop

M 1 R – Lift stitch from back to front. K in front loop

SSK – Slip stitches as if to knit.

Now we are going to start the increases to shape the bottom of the leaf

Starting on the wrong side:

1) k1, p1, k1

2) k1, m1r, k1, m1l, k1 (5)

3) k2, p1, k2

4) k2, m1r, k1, m1l, k2 (7)

5) k3, p1, k3

6) k3, m1r, k1, m1l, k3 (9)

7) k4, p1, k4

8) k4, m1r, k1, m1l, k4 (11)

9) k5, p1, k5

10) k5, m1r, k1, m1l, k5 (13)

11) k6, p1, k6

12) k6, m1r, k1, m1l, k6 (15)

13) k7, p1, k7

Now we will start the decreases to shape the top of the leaf.

Starting on the right side:

14) ssk, k11, k2tog (13)

15) k6, p1, k6

16) ssk, k9, k2tog (11)

17) k5, p1, k5

18) ssk, k7, k2tog (9)

19) k4, p1, k4

20) ssk, k5, k2tog (7)

21) k3, p1, k3

22) ssk, k3, k2tog (5)

23) k2, p1, k2

24) ssk, k1, k2tog (3)

25) k1, p1 k1

26) k3tog (1)
